1 Corinthians 7:1-7

Introduction: The present day church will not talk about one of the main drives and the sources of sin in the modern world. That is sex.

I. God Created Sex For Marriage, v. 1-2

- A. We are created “very good” Genesis 1:31
There is a reason God created you this way
- B. Sex is discussed in Scripture
Heb 13:4 Marriage is honorable among all, and bed undefiled;
but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.
Song of Solomon
Discussed bad: Abraham, Lot, Judah, David, Solomon
Discussed good: Jacob and Rachael, Boaz and Ruth

II. You Have A Sexual Drive, v. 3-4

- A. Godly sex is not selfish, it is loving and serving
Husband to wife, wife to husband: expression of love
- B. The Dangers
Every part of us good but can be corrupted (spiritual, sexual)
Watch your situation
1 Corinthians 6:18, Genesis 39:10

III. Your Spouse Has A Sexual Drive, v. 5

- A. Sex is an expression of love and service
Gary Chapman love languages: touch, affirmation, service
Show spouse they are loved and special
- B. You are called to help your spouse be a Christian
1 Peter 3:1-7 Bring them to Christ, not push them away

IV. Your Sexual Drive Does Not Define You, v. 6-7

- A. Your relationship with God defines you
You belong to Christ: 1 Cor. 6:20 Bought with a price
Follow him in every way that you can
Mt. 19:10-12 Some are eunuchs due to relationship with God
- B. Our role
Be holy in every situation, whatever state you are in
